



Riesling Ice Wine

Notes from the Winemakers

As luminous as a beaming winter morning in Northern Michigan, Bel Lago's Riesling ice wine is an opulent and silken delight. With a radiating golden hue, this ice wine has aromas of honeysuckle, white flowers and apricot with flavors of peach, citrus and caramelized golden raspberries. With plenty of acid to balance this wine's high sugar content, its luxurious and plush mouthfeel round out the decadent experience. Handpicked frozen off the vine and fermented for months, Bel Lago's Riesling ice wine truly is a rare, labor of love.

Composition

100% Riesling

Production Notes

Hand-picked at a temperature of 16F on Dec. 13, 2017 by a small group of Bel Lago's vineyard and winemaking teams, only one-and-a-half tons of Riesling was harvested at an average of 43.6 brix. After pressing the frozen fruit for two days, only 350 liters of juice was captured. The juice was then fermented for nine months using the yeast RHST.
